

Riders should be capable of the ride distance. Rides have generous breaks and are at an average pace of 15 to 20 km/hr, depending on terrain. You need a well maintained bike with good tyres and brakes and should wear high visibility clothing. Sunday rides start at 9:00am and generally finish mid-afternoon and rarely after 4:00pm. Bring lunch, plenty of drink, rain gear, a puncture outfit, a spare tube and a personal First Aid kit. **Please ring the ride leader to advise that you will be joining the ride - If you want to carpool (10c / km).** If weather conditions are extreme refer to the ride leader or the club Facebook Page or web site.
